Superintendent Reports

- The principal for each school gave a report on the progress of their goals for the school.
- Dr. Gregg Klinginsmith, Superintendent, gave the financial update and an update on Prop R3.

Contracts and Agreements

- The district approved a contract with Clothes Bin to place a clothing and shoe recycling bin at Black Hawk Middle School. The district will earn \$0.07 per pound.
- A contract with Renaissance Star Assessment was approved for a total of \$17,325.89.
- A contract with Youth In Need was approved to continue providing early childhood services in all our elementary schools. There is no cost to the district.
- A contract with Start 2 Finish was approved to provide timing equipment for a cross county meet in the fall. The total cost is \$2,000.
- A contract with MOREnet was approved to provide cyber security training to staff. The total cost is \$1,402.50.

Old Business

Communication Tower

The district approved Radio Communication Company (RCC) to test new equipment on an existing structure to determine if the plan will work. The total cost of this test is \$1.822.50.

Negotiations

The 2024-2025 collective bargaining agreement was approved. Some highlights are:

Bus Driver starting pay is \$20 an hour

The minimum wage for any employee is \$13.00

The starting teacher salary was moved to \$39,169.

All coaching and sponsor positions will increase in pay by 10%

All staff will receive one week of paid maternity/paternity leave.
