Contract Approvals:

- Contracts were approved with myfunrun.com, who organizes the Daniel Boone Elementary School Fun Run, the Coole School Planner Contract - the Warrior Ridge Elementary School Planner, the Center for Autism, which provides for the placement of three students for the 2019-2020 school year, a contract with Advanced Elevator to service the elevator at Warrenton High School, and a contract with Youth in Need to provide Pre-K services in district buildings. Policy Approvals:

New Business:

- The board approved the special education academic achievement plan.

- The board approved a contract with Mr. Kenny Dildine to continue athletic training services throughout the summer. Mr. Dildine will be paid \$25 per hour for his services. The district is putting out a request for proposal to find a new service for athletic training for the 19-20 school year. The district's former athletic training service provider has decided to no longer service the area.
