Policy Approvals

Policy BBB and Administrative Procedure BBB were approved in regards to school board elections. A new law was passed shortening the filing period for school board elections. Budget Revision #1

The first budget revision of the 21-22 school year was approved. The budgeted revenue for the year is now \$44,687,531 and the budgeted expenditures is now \$43,135,936.

21-22 Staffing Plan Amendment

Two unused paraprofessional positions were converted to one technology position to better support the 1:1 chromebook initiative at Warrenton High School. All other positions that were added with ESSER funds and test to stay funds have also been included.

22-23 Academic Calendar

The 2022-23 academic calendar has been approved. The calendar is very similar to the 21-22 calendar.
