Hello Warren County R-III Families,

Below is information from the September 22, 2022 Warren County R-III School Board meeting.

Career Ladder

The board of education has approved participating in stage 1 of "career ladder." At the end of the 2022 legislative session, the state legislators approved a program called "career ladder." This program pays teachers with more than two years of experience \$1,500 for working an additional 50 hours outside of their contracted day for work they are not already being compensated for. The state is funding 60% of this program and district is responsible for the remaining 40%. The cost of the program is dependent on how many teachers participate. The maximum cost to the district is \$146,331.

Community Collaboration

The board of education engaged in a collaboration with community members regarding a future bond issue in April 2024. No decisions were made.
